

Day 4 - Browning to Fernie



Day 5 - Fernie to Longview


Day 9 - Revelstoke to Nelson



Day 11 - Coeur d'Alene to Missoula

- 2) Optional, 12 miles of gravel (possibly marginal and downhill) otherwise awesome looking ride on St. Joe River Rd from St Maries to St Regis, has more Interstate than base route, this route is not shown below.

- 4) Good idea to get fuel at Conoco or Exxon in Kinston off I-90



Day 12 - Missoula to Dillon

- 1) Pass by ranch entrance where Yellowstone was filmed.
- 2) Fuel is scarce along this route. Top off at Conoco on map. There looks to be fuel near Fetty's and H-Bar, but it's sketchy. About 150 miles from Conoco to Dillon. Everyone should be able to make that if needed.
- 3) Lunch at Fetty's (2+19 from start) or H Bar J Saloon (another 45 mins), that's about it.
- 4) Pioneer Scenic Byway, doesn't look highly traveled and a change of scenery
- 5) Not many hotels in this area, Dillon is on I-15, so probably enough. Next major stop is Idaho Falls (2 hours south).
- 6) If someone needs to end early, Missoula to Cody is 6 hours mostly along I-90.
- 7) This is a longer day than I like, but options were limited.
- 8) Depending on progress, this has good potential for a rest day. Even the last 2 days are sorta longish.



- 7) Pretty much the natural wilderness this route + a few tourists, three towns population 1600, 1000, 600 in between Revelstoke and Nelson




